

## SHORTLISTING OF BEE AND SME SUPPLIERS TO SUPPLY RESERVED COMMODITIES TO ERONGO RED FOR THE PERIOD 1 JULY 2021 UNTIL 30 JUNE 2022

The revised Erongo RED procurement strategy is intended to create an enabling environment for promoting the participation of previously disadvantaged Namibians, including Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs) in procurement activities. It is also intended to promote training and skills transfers through partnerships and joint ventures.

Erongo RED reserved the following activities to be supplied by shortlisted SME and BEE (Black Economic Empowerment) enterprises for the period 1 July 2021 until 30 June 2022. This list of reserved activities will be reviewed annually.

Preference will be given to suppliers based and operating in the specific town within the Erongo Region where the goods are required. The procurement for goods or services reserved will not exceed the amount of N\$ 300 000.00 and/or a service contract with a term longer than three (3) years.

The reservation applies to the following goods and services:

• <b>De-bushing Services:</b>	Where no specialised machinery are required. (Excluding de-bushing on private land).
• <b>Taring Services:</b>	Where no specialised machinery are required.
• <b>Paving Services:</b>	Related to repairs and maintenance due to trenching and digging.
• <b>Trenching and digging Services:</b>	Where no specialised machinery are required.
• <b>Food &amp; Beverages:</b>	Takeaway meals, platters, pastries, tea, coffee, sugar, milk, biscuits, bottled water, cool drinks and juice.
• <b>Catering Services:</b>	Cooked meals and drinks/cool drinks/water/juice which is served with meals at a specific location.
• <b>Gift baskets and hampers:</b>	Gifts of gratitude which includes food, drinks and/or confectionaries (sweets).
• <b>Cleaning Services:</b>	Office cleaning and window cleaning.
• <b>Laundry Services:</b>	Washing of clothes, bedding and tableware.
• <b>Arts &amp; Crafts:</b>	Artworks, music, musicians and local crafts.

• <b>Tailoring and Sowing Services:</b>	Manufacturing of clothes and/or mending of garments.
• <b>Building Maintenance Services:</b>	Painting, general repairs to doors, hinges, windows, locks and boundary walls.
• <b>Plumbing Services:</b>	General repairs and maintenance.
• <b>Tiling Services:</b>	General repairs and maintenance.

Interested companies that meet the following criteria are requested to complete application forms on the Tara Nawa website, [www.webportunities.net](http://www.webportunities.net) in order to be evaluated and considered for shortlisting:

- Namibian registered small and medium enterprises;
- Namibian registered joint venture businesses;
- Namibian manufacturers and service providers;
- Businesses owned by previously disadvantaged Namibians;
- Companies must have the necessary qualifications, capabilities, experience and have the appropriate equipment of facilities to provide the goods/services or works required;
- Companies must have the legal capacity to enter into a procurement contract;
- Companies should not have been declared insolvent or bankrupt or is not under curatorship or being wounded up under the law;
- Companies should not have been debarred from participating in Erongo RED procurement processes.
- Are in good standing with the Receiver of Revenue in respect of all rates (e.g. Income Tax, VAT and PAYE) as well as from the Social Security Commission.
