

PUBLIC NOTICE:

SHORTLISTING OF BEE AND SME SUPPLIERS TO SUPPLY RESERVED COMMODITIES TO ERONGO RED FOR THE PERIOD 1 JULY 2022 UNTIL 30 JUNE 2023

Erongo RED's procurement strategy is intended to give effect to an enabling environment for increasing the participation of previously disadvantaged Namibians and small and medium enterprises (SMEs) in procurement activities as well as promoting training and skills transfers through partnerships and joint ventures.

Erongo RED reserved the following activities to be supplied by shortlisted SME and BEE enterprises for the period **1 July 2022 until 30 June 2023**. This list of reserved activities will be reviewed annually.

Reservation will be given to suppliers based and operating in the specific town within the Erongo Region where the goods are required.

The reservation applies to the following goods and services:

•	De-bushing Services:
	Where no specialized machinery are required. (Excluding de-bushing on private land).
•	Taring Services:
	Where no specialized machinery are required.
•	Paving Services:
	Related to repairs and maintenance due to trenching and digging.
•	Trenching and digging Services:
	Where no specialized machinery are required.
•	Food & Beverages:
	Takeaway meals, platters, pastries, Tee, Coffee, Sugar, Milk, Biscuits, bottled water, cool drinks and juice.
•	Catering Services:
	Cooked meals and drinks/cool drinks/water/juice which is served with meals at a specific location.
•	Building Maintenance Services:
	Painting, General Repairs to doors, hinges, windows, locks and boundary walls.
•	Plumbing Services:
	General Repairs and Maintenance.
•	Tiling Services:
	General Repairs and Maintenance.

Erongo RED established in 2005 and is registered under the Companies Act of Namibia. The company has a significant presence in Erongo Region; and currently provides electricity to towns and villages in the Erongo Region and their surrounding farming and rural areas. It is the only company in Namibia that offers electricity

as low as N\$1,44* per unit. Erongo RED has through the implementation of the new tariff structures actually empowered the consumer to be in control of his/her electricity bill

Interested companies that meet the following criteria are requested to complete application forms on the Tara Nawa website, **www.webportunities.net** in order to be evaluated and considered for shortlisting:

- Namibian registered small and medium enterprises;
- Namibian registered joint venture businesses;
- Namibian manufacturers and service providers;
- Businesses owned by previously disadvantaged Namibians;
- Companies must have the necessary qualifications, capabilities, experience, and have the appropriate equipment of facilities to provide the goods/services or works required;
- Companies must have the legal capacity to enter into a procurement contract;
- Companies should not have been declared insolvent or bankrupt or is not under curatorship or being wounded up under the law;
- Companies should not have been debarred from participating in Erongo RED procurement processes.
- Are in good standing with the Receiver of Revenue in respect of all rates (e.g. Income Tax, VAT, and PAYE) as well as from the Social Security Commission.
